

This is the third book in the Jackman and Evans series. In this book a new character joins them in the shape of D.S.Carter Maclean, The sole survivor of a plane crash in which his four best friends perished. He is haunted by their appearances to him and finds a coping mechanism by completing a task for each of them until they finally disappear. Alongside this are two other investigations for D.I.Jackman and D.S.Evans and the team to solve. The investigation into the disappearance of the wife of one of D.S. Macleans dead friends and the stalking and kidnap of Superintendant Ruth Crookes neice Leah. This is another great procedural from Joy Ellis! It could be read as a standalone though I would definately recommend reading the series in order as the characters develop throughout and add so much to the enjoyment of the series. This third book is full of twists and turns, characters that you can relate too and held my interest right up until the final and rather sad ending to the story of D.S.Maclean. I read this book over two days and cant wait for the next in the series as they just keep getting better and better. Thanks to Joffe books for the opportunity to read this as an arc. Detective Carter McLean suffers from survivor's guilt. While on a fun weekend with his four best friends, the plane crashes and kills everyone but himself. But that's not the last he sees of his friends. His friends visit him. Realistically, Carter does not believe in ghosts, but he sees them, always accompanied by the smell of smoke. These were all young men and they all left things undone. Carter decides to honor them by completing something each of them has left undone. His supervisors have him sitting at a desk, not knowing how he will handle the stress of dealing with victims, suspects. Even some of his colleagues worry about him. He is still under the care of a psychiatrist. Meanwhile, the police department doesn't shut down. Multiple cases are being handled by the team of detectives under DI Jackman. There is a missing woman who has ties to Carter. Another young woman has a stalker .. she happens to be the niece of one of their supervisors. I have read several books by this author ... and by far, this is the best ever. The premise is extraordinary and so well written. The characters are terrific, especially Carter. I felt such compassion for him and his circumstances. There is constant movement, as the cases are investigated and how all seem related in one way or another. The ending was so surprising. I had envisioned several scenarios ... but I never, ever saw this one coming. Many, many thanks to the author and Joffe Books for the advanced digital copy of THE FOURTH FRIEND. 5 stars DI Rowan Jackman and DS Marie Evans make a return in this novel about a young detective named DS Carter McLean who witnessed the death of his four good friends in the same plane crash that he survived. After eighteen months of convalescence, Carter returns to work. Evans, who is a close friend of Carter's, especially feels that all is not well. Jackman and Evans are currently investigating the disappearance of Suzanne Holland who is the wife of one of Carter's dead

friends. They, and the psychologist who is seeing Carter, think that perhaps he should not be involved in the Holland investigation, but the bosses overrule them. McLean is under the impression that his dead friends want him to complete certain tasks that they didn't get to do before they died. For one, it was running a marathon for his father, for another it's to find some money he had hidden away to give to his girlfriend, and so on. When Superintendent Ruth Crooke's young niece Leah is being followed, she asks Jackman and McLean and Evans can look into the case. McLean and Crooke can't stand each other for some reason. Carter uses his unique contacts to locate the bad guys who kidnapped the girl and this leads him to the suspect. Through interviews, they learn that all of the harassing was done at the behest of another person, but the suspect changed the rules. Now they need to find the person who ordered the whole thing. Meanwhile, on the Holland case, they receive some interesting information from Ms. Holland's ex-husband, now living in Spain. They track down another lead and receive some exciting news from the forensic side. The ending is very sad and yet it is exciting. The book is very well written and plotted, as are all of Joy Ellis' novels. The tension started immediately as the reader wonders what will become of Carter McLean and continues throughout the book as we not only try to sort out the clues to the cases, but also worry about Carter. I like the way Jackman and Evans' team get along. They seem to respect one another, and not all detective stories read that way. Well done, Ms. Ellis, and I hope another book is out soon!
