

I love the Texas Almanac. I was born in Lufkin, Angelina County, on March 15, 1925. In 1925 my father, Radford B. Allen, Sr, owned and operated a grocery store on the county courthouse square in Lufkin. The last time I was in Lufkin, his store location was an attorney's office. My father was the youngest of 12 children born (in 1895) to Hiram Andrew and Ann Elizabeth Allen. Hiram Andrew was better known as "Uncle Bud" to friends and "Grandpap" to his many grandchildren. He owned and operated a large farm near the community know as "Allentown," named after him and his father, Hiram George, a Confederate Army veteran (1st Sergeant) of Walker's Texas Division. The Texas Almanac shows "Allentown" on the Angelina County map, page 240, northeast of Lufkin near the Angelina River. Dad and his brothers fished the Angelina as boys and as grown men. Radford B. Allen, Jr.; Fort Worth, Texas.
