

This is by far the best resource available on the five tiny towns that form the "Cinque Terre" of the Italian Riviera. Written in Rick Steves' usual affable yet practical style, the book is packed with information on the Cinque Terre as well as some general Italy information for the traveller.

Production value is high, with glossy paper and color photos throughout; each town gets its own color-coded chapter. The Cinque Terre themselves are an extremely popular and picturesque tourist destination on the Ligurian coast between La Spezia and Portofino. For me the best feature of all is the map which folds out from the back cover (but can be removed if you like via a perforated tear line): on one side is an orientation map showing all five towns and on the reverse is an individual street map, with points of interest, for each of the five towns. Although small (about 10" x 19" when unfolded) and featuring what are literally "street" maps (most of these towns are built around a single main street), this map is a precious resource very hard to find otherwise. This book is a must have if you are considering a visit to the area.
