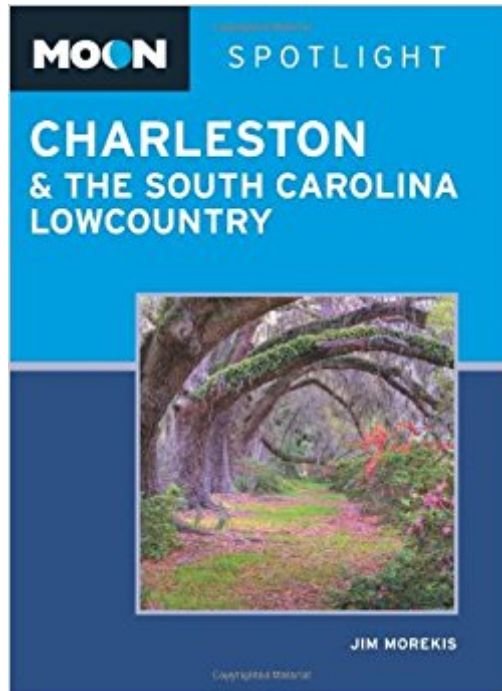

He has traveled up and down the Carolinas and continues to find new spots and things to do on this historic and hospitable stretch of coast. Jim's favorite Carolina pastimes include relaxing on Edisto Island, climbing lighthouses on the Outer Banks, eating shrimp and grits in Charleston, playing miniature golf at Myrtle Beach, and walking through old cemeteries. I cannot overstate how helpful this book is for navigating and planning a trip. It gives a concise history of Charleston, and contains a surprising amount of useful, wittily-written info for the serious traveler. The book is broken down by geography and a handy series of sections on what to do and where to go. I will be buying more books from Mr. Morekis, because he helped me plan the best Charleston vacation for my needs.

Used this guide almost exclusively on a recent 5-day trip to Charleston. The recommendations for both attractions and places to eat were quite good and completely accurate. We did not use the hotel recommendations since the hotels in downtown Charleston are all quite expensive. If driving it will save a lot of money to stay outside the downtown area and just park the car in a garage once you get there.
