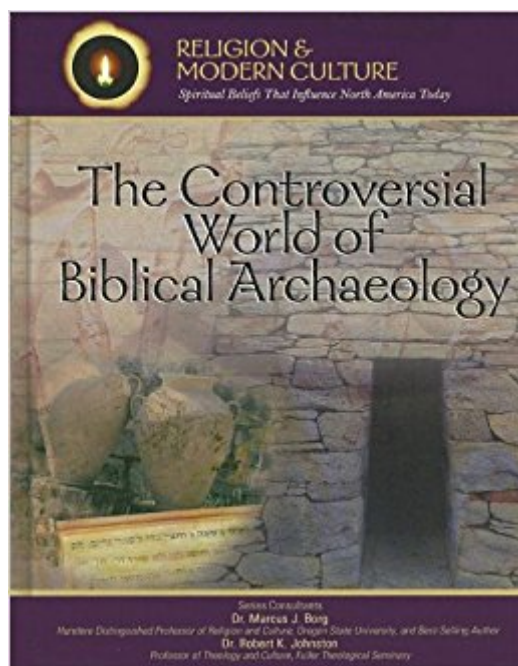




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The Controversial World Of Biblical Archaeology: Tomb Raiders, Fakes, & Scholars (Religion And Modern Culture)
