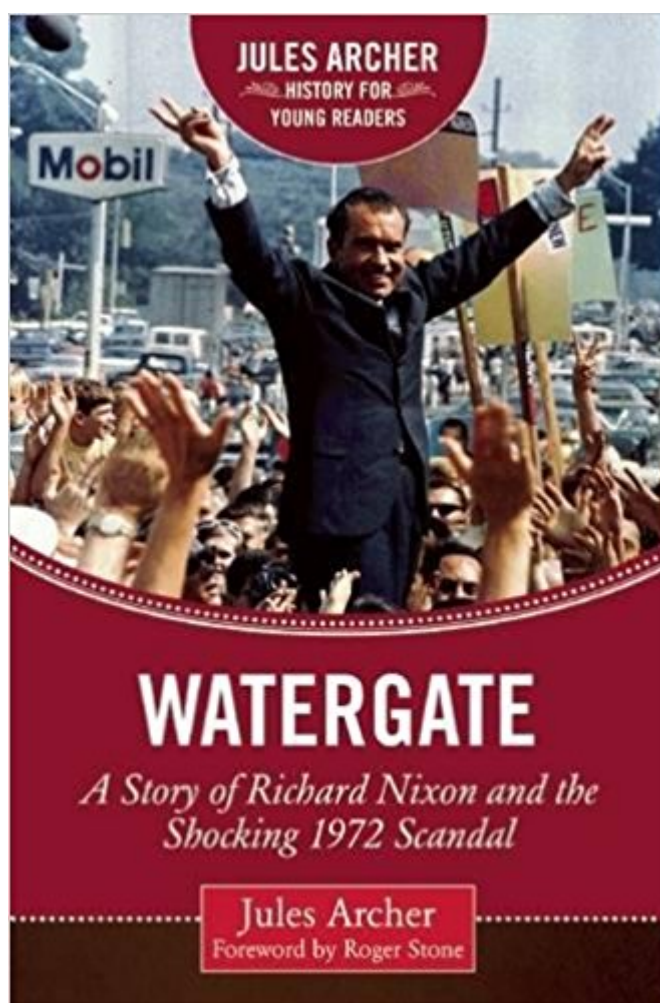


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Watergate: A Story Of Richard Nixon And The Shocking 1972 Scandal (Jules Archer History For Young Readers)
