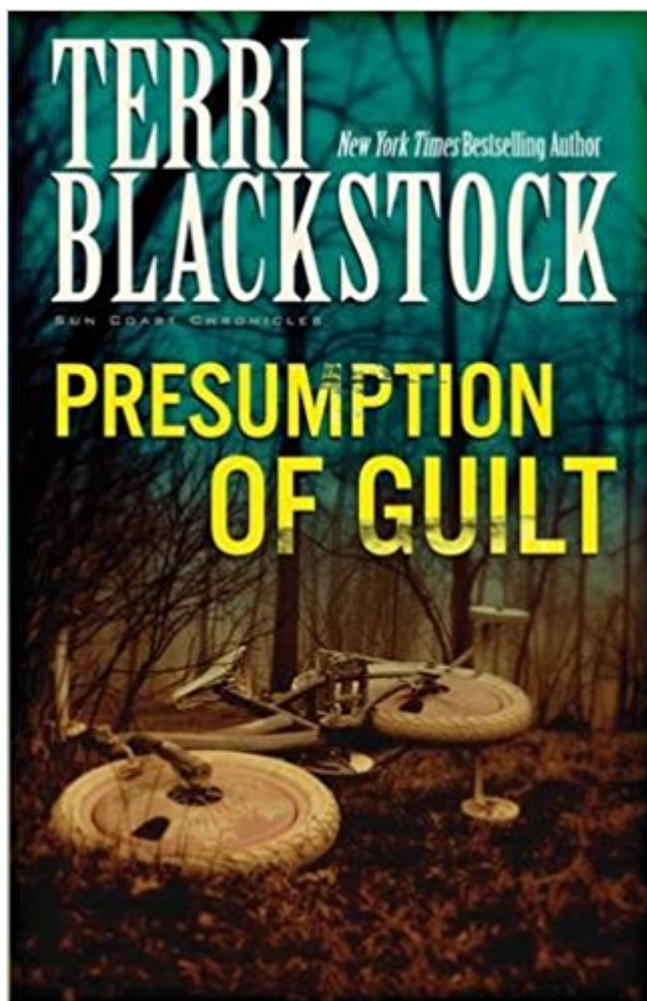




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Presumption Of Guilt (Suncoast Chronicles Series #4)
