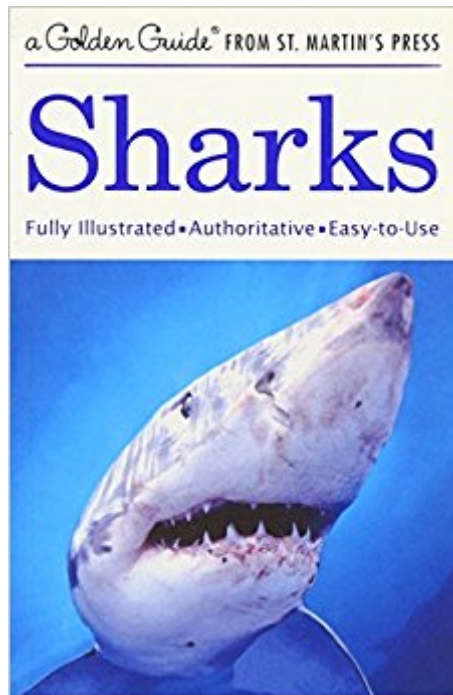




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Sharks: A Golden Guide From St. Martin's Press

Golden Guides first appeared in 1949 and quickly established themselves as authorities on subjects from Natural History to Science. Relaunched in 2000, Golden Guides from St. Martin's Press feature modern, new covers as part of a multi-year, million-dollar program to revise, update, and expand the complete line of guides for a new generation of students.

Skimped on the illustrations we love from the original publications. Has a feeling of being rushed. Should have put more genuine effort into matching the rich and full illustrations of the original series. Lame artwork compared to the early golden guides, as if we would not notice.

I have several of these books, originally bought for my children, but they are great for adults too. It makes quick ID of a plant, reptile, star, or shark very easy with a few quick paragraphs and picture.

Did you know that when you're about to be bitten in half by a great white shark, its jaws actually extend out of its mouth for a better bite, while a protective coating covers its eyelids to prevent anything poking it in the eyes? Sharks will probably be one of the most useful books that you will ever own if you like to go swimming a lot. With the detailed description and colorful illustrations, you will be able to tell your mako shark bite from your tiger shark bite. With a detailed introduction on how the giant dinosaur-sized sharks of the past evolved into the ones we know today - making it literally one of the oldest fish in the sea - as well as specifications on differentiating between sharks, the book is a useful tool for any would-be marine biologist. And once you have this pocket-sized book you can show off to your friends about the Carcharodon carcharias you ran into the other day: they'll have no idea what you're talking about while you'll know you mean a great white.
