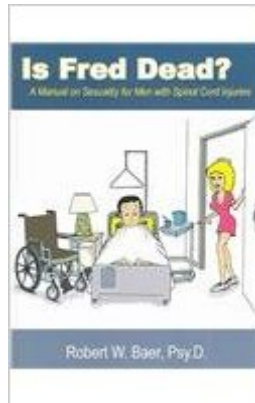

Dr. Baer has twelve years of experience working in community mental health and private rehabilitation. Together with his wife of eleven years, Susan, Dr. Baer presents seminars on sexuality and disabilities, erectile dysfunction, and living with a spouse with a disability.

Men with spinal cord injuries have questions on sexuality and self-worth, but most studies on the topic narrow the focus to the concern of fertility. Robert Baer has had years of experience working in community mental health and private rehabilitation, presenting seminars on sexuality and disabilities: *Is Fred Dead? A Manual On Sexuality For Men With Spinal Cord Injuries* is a practical manual on sexuality for men with spinal cord injuries which addresses issues ranging from dating and understanding the sexual response cycle to sex alternatives.

Dr. Baer has covered all the essential topics that a male with a SCI would want to know: from detailed anatomic drawings to illustrate positions, to relationship issues (e.g., how to handle catheters in an intimate situation) and how to handle the interpersonal issues. This is a thoughtful, rigorous book that is educational, not purient, and written from first-hand experience. For both patients and their loved ones.
