I'm so glad this book exists! I've been trying to figure out how to draw my own comic book figures for a while now (planning to make my own comic), but didn't encounter any good guides until this one. I can already draw simple figures, but with the help of this book I'll be able to turn my characters alive by making them look realistic in doing a variety of poses. There are plenty of examples together with clear explanations.

The book was ok. Not really what I expected in terms of step by step drawing lessons.

"Draw Action Figures" is a great and recommended book for those seeking to develop (or recall) the high level perspective needed to draw action figures. It helps me refresh what I learned years ago when I used to draw. Touching upon issues like proportions, direction of action, pose and other high level perspectives that need to be addressed before drilling down to more specific details, Vincent Noot helped me recall old days and focus my practicing efforts.

Before this guide, my biggest challenge was getting proportions right. This book addressed that point well and helped me improve my technique. If you'd like to learn or improve your drawing skills (specifically, figures), I'd recommend this book.

This book is not for beginners, and I highly recommend that anyone interested in this book also purchase the author's Book 1: How to Draw Action Figures: Book 1: More than 130 Sketches of Action Figures and Action Poses (Drawing Action Figures, Draw Action Figures Book, How Draw Action Poses, Draw Comic Figures) for more basic instruction in drawing action figures. Although the book is short, it is filled with helpful examples and clear explanations of how an artist can depict action in an illustration, especially in graphic novels. The last section of the book shows how a rudimentary black and white sketch is transformed into a colorful action figure charging right at you.

Great book. If you are interested in learning how to draw all types of figures, then this is the book for you. I like how it doesn't just show how to draw creatures, but also things as simple as just a girl or boy and girl. It gives visuals as well which I really like.
