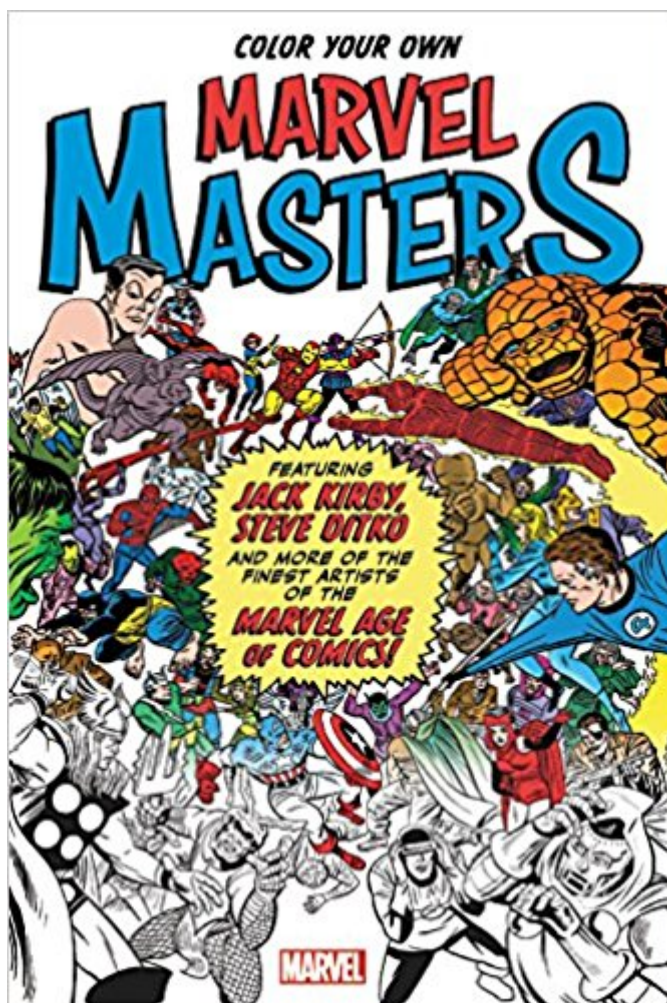

Decent overview of classic Marvel Art for you to color in yourself- surprising variety of pictures in this one. Recommend oil based colored pencils such as the Lyra brand for best results in this case. Very detailed pictures make this worth the buy. A flashback to a more creative time.

My first adult coloring book, so I really can't comment on the quality of the paper for its intended use, though pages are perforated & images are only on one side, so that is appropriate. As a big, long time (like almost 60 years) comic book fan I jumped at this title. Good selection of early Marvel

illustrations. Decent amount of Jack Kirby's excellent work, though shame they used a lot of pretty static images (pin-up pages mainly from old Fantastic Four mags), rather than full page splash panels or covers with more dynamics. And they don't even include the book's cover image to color (Fantastic Four annual - 3 or 4?) - a great page to color in! Though he is mentioned prominently on both front & back cover, there is not enough Steve Ditko! Been through book twice & have not seen any images of his Dr. Strange - more great images to color. Understand they publish a separate coloring book of Dr. Strange, but they are doing one of Thor too & there are several pages here of Thor (admittedly by Kirby), besides Spider-man who also has his own coloring book (glad they did include one Ditko Spider-man here so we had @ least some Ditko, though most all of the Spidey pages included are by Romita Sr.). Not sure why they included 2 images of Devil Dinosaur (though again Kirby), a minor Marvel character @ best & wonder @ the inclusion of Groot (I know - to cash in on the Guardians movie) from a pretty obscure pre-superhero Marvel mag. Still, I give this book 4 stars, one star deducted for not enough Ditko, the use of too many pin up pages and not including the cover for coloring. Overall - recommended for any fan of classic Marvel who wants a little leisure activity coloring & maybe they'll have more Ditko & even better images if they publish a Volume 2!
