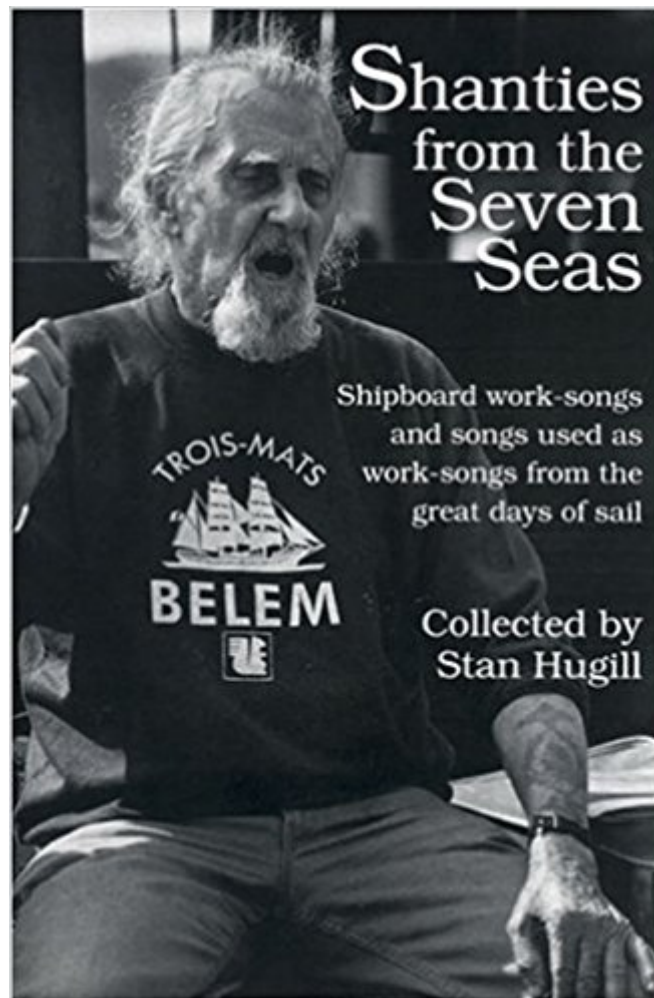




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Shanties From The Seven Seas (Maritime)

I, myself, am a violinist and an author, not at all a singer, but I have an interest in shanties and songs from the seven seas, and found this book to be an invaluable addition to my reference collection.
