

Synopsis

He discusses ways in which male and female bodies are similar, and then highlights ways in which they are different. He talks about the role of the skeleton, the fat deposits, and the skin in creating the superficial form of the body. Finally, he discusses the features of the face. This book includes 122 marvelous illustrations drawn by Richer in black & white, a translator's preface, and an index. In this book, Richer emphasizes the variable qualities that make each individual unique. This text is unlike any other book on human anatomy and will be a valuable resource for artists working in any art medium.

Dr. Paul Richer (1849-1933) was the leading French instructor of artistic anatomy at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts, Paris from 1903-1922. He was a practicing physician specializing in neuroscience and a member of the National Academy of Medicine in France. In addition, he was a highly accomplished figurative sculptor. His works are found in the Musee d'Orsay. Allana M. Benham is a practicing artist and a specialist in artistic anatomy. She teaches at Atelier de Bresoles in Montreal.
