Synopsis

BOB COSTAS has won twenty-four Emmy Awards - more than any other sports broadcaster - and has been a prominent part of the coverage of every major sport over the past three decades. His versatility has been recognized with awards and nominations in the categories of hosting, play-by-play, writing, journalism, news, and entertainment. He is the only person ever to have won Emmys in news, sports, and entertainment. Bob's peers have named him the 'National

Sportscaster of the Year' a record eight times, and in 2012, he was elected to the National Sportscasters and Sportswriters Hall of Fame and selected for the Walter Cronkite Award for distinction in journalism. Bob's thoughtful commentaries on a variety of issues have established him as one of his generation's most distinctive voices.

I thoroughly enjoyed the recordings but I AM disappointed with the way in which they were handled, production-wise. I edit video/audio for a living so I know what I'm talking about and I can only describe the editing & production techniques used in BASEBALL FOREVER as "Lazy". This material deserves better treatment. I echo some of the criticisms posted in previous reviews. First and foremost, this collection SCREAMS for liner notes. While the Bob Costas narrations provide settings, they all too often do not bother to identify the announcers involved and that is a shame. I also agree with the complaint about the fading out of clips. No excuse for that. The segues between cuts are unnecessarily loose and some of the clips ramble on long after the "meat" of the segment has aired. Worse, the fadeouts are all punctuated by "dead air" before the next cut. The Costas voice-overs could have easily overlapped the beginnings and endings of the recordings for seamless transitions. Production criticisms aside, it's STILL a "must have" for baseball fans. The set, naturally, includes Giants' play-by-play man, Russ Hodges', well-known call of Bobby Thomson's 1951 "Shot Heard 'Round the World". I love that it also gives you the Dodgers', Red Barber, calling the same play AND Gordon McLendon's call of it on the Liberty Network. Thanks to some of the other reviewers, I knew it was flawed when I ordered it. That said, I'm STILL happy to have it in my audio library and I do recommend it.

My 90 year old father lived through the years detailed in this audio cd. He has been reminded of many players long forgotten. It is a great journey through baseball history.

Despite what others have said, this is a remarkable set of recordings. There IS a list of the tracks in the box, though it is mostly the dates they occurred. But, if you are a baseball fan, you will recognize them. I really liked hearing the "Shot Heard Round the World" from multiple announcers. I could even stand Bob Costas:)

These CDs are an amazing collections of excerpts from radio broadcasts of baseball games that'll leave you wanting more. It includes the well-known calls as well as some you probably haven't heard before. I can't wait to listen to these CDs again!

You have no idea what is really on the cd's or in which order.No time lengths either. This would have been a much better package if someone took the time to care about what's important to the consumer.It's ridiculous to sit through 4 hours of highlights when you can pick which ones you'd like to hear first then,listen to the others. We,who bought this will have to make our own track list.

This is a very vivid account of baseball radio play-by-play and I enjoyed it. My only objection is that the announcers were not named along with the individual broadcast segments. There was a section devoted to them at the end, but I would have liked hearing the broadcasters identified with each segment.
