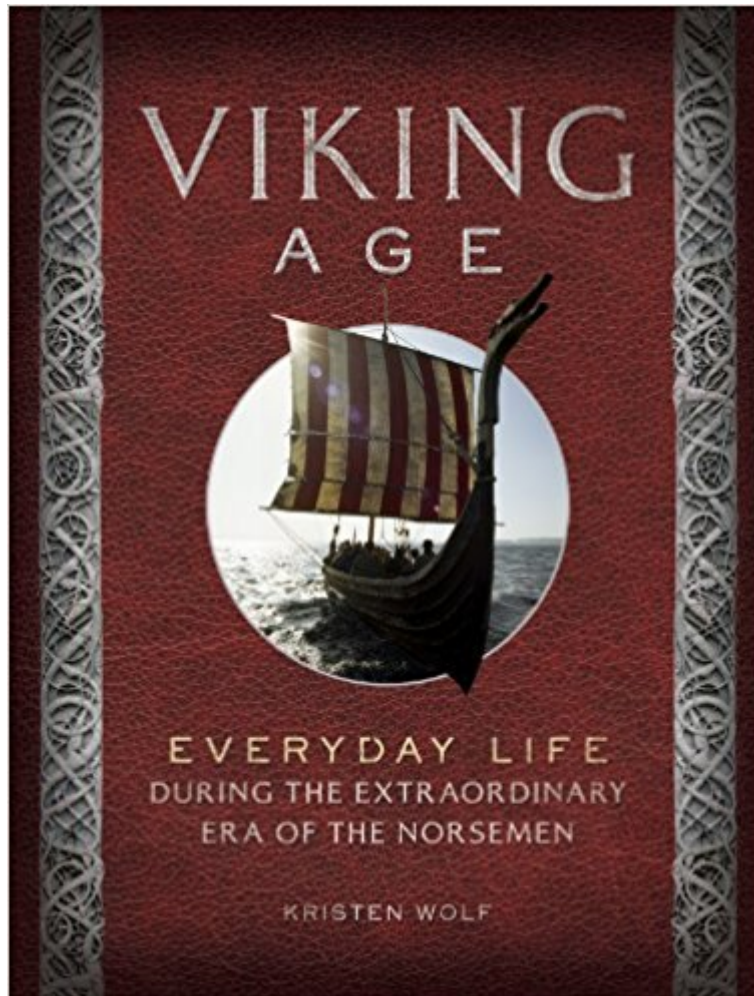




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Viking Age: Everyday Life During The Extraordinary Era Of The Norsemen

She is currently working on an edition of AM 672 4to, an Icelandic handbook for priests from the fifteenth century, and is associate editor of the Journal of English and Germanic Philology. Professor Wolf lives in Madison, WI.

This book is a general overview of most parts of life in the Viking Age. It contains many fascinating bits of details, some of which I'd love to read about in more detail. However, the writing is a bit on the dry side. I kept catching myself skimming and not paying attention until I snagged over an interesting detail.

The sections about language went into detail only a linguist or speech pathologist would appreciate. The sections about art were way too detailed as well. It was okay but I wouldn't buy it again.

Excellent introduction to the Viking Age, as well as the Viking communities & how they lived; this is a very good book to begin learning about the Viking Age as well as the Viking peoples and what their lives entailed
