

I received an ARC for an honest review. For a man who didn't begin writing until he was in his 70s, Mr. Rundell truly knows how to engage the reader. The family we've been following has just hit the adulthood of the next generation, and the real feel of the locale, the weather, the dramatic elements, and the growth of the characters simply make for a joy to read. Now, you don't need to have read any of the previous books in the series, but it will enhance the pleasure of knowing the background of our hero. And hero he is, from defending women, to defeating Indian attacks, to riding shotgun on a stage, this young man is a marvelous phenomenon created by Mr. Rundell. In the beginning of the book, I just kept trying to figure out who would play him in the movie that should be made. But the events Mr. Rundell plays out leaves all thoughts of someone playing the characters behind. All thoughts are on the current and then the next event. Magnificent tale by a master storyteller.
