

The title of the book is Building a World Class Compliance Program. A history lesson doesnt help, nor does repeating the same thing over and over again chapter after chapter as if the people charged with the task of building a compliance program arent capable of getting the point the first, second, third, tenth time around. As far as I'm concerned this book needs to either be renamed, or completely overhauled.
