book. the flaps are softer paper, not hard, but they're nicely laminated. it is a book which just has the 8 planets. i was hoping it would have more about rockets and space shuttles, but it's nice for what it is. vibrant colors and my 2 yr old seems to like it.

Love the content and flow of this book, but the flaps aren't sturdy enough to hold up to my one year old. We have several flap-books which she loves, but this one seems a little easier to tear off than our others.

Got this for my 4-year-old who loves rockets and space and is still really into lift-the-flap books. He likes it well enough and has asked for it a few times for night-time reading. It's a quick read, just a couple of minutes.

This is one of my favorite books. It taught my two year olds the names of the planets. The pictures are beautiful. The only reasons why I did not give four stars is that on the first page there is a picture of the solar system and the sun is on the right side of the page. This makes it confusing because the planets do not go in their typical left-to-right order. I just flip the book to make it easier. Also, there is no mention of Pluto in the book. The other space book I have lists Pluto as a dwarf planet which I like better than leaving it out.

The flaps are cheap and the story is generic. My son has already ripped the planets off the pages. It looks like a cute book, the graphics aren't bad, but it's just cheaply made.

My daughter LOVES this book and she is 1.5yrs. She knows her planets thanks to this book! The colorful pictures and flaps make this super fun to read with the little ones.

I love the idea of this book, but when you lift the flap it doesn't show anything but over-simplified views of the planet. The text is REALLY good at explaining and introducing a child to each planet though!!

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
