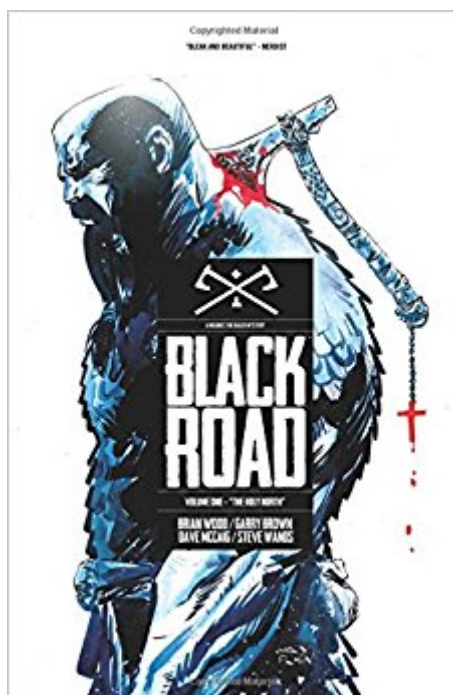

The plot is so intriguing that I am looking forward to the next volume. The characters are interesting - with their own twists, flaws and motivations - you're not left thinking why is this character here, or oh I see this is the comic relief character.

Knowing the work of Brian Wood, I took a chance and ordered this graphic novel. I can honestly say this is some of his best work. Brian Wood can construct a story that has so many layers you almost wonder how long it took him to layer them. This being the first arc, is the "set-up" arc, as many comic fans will know. However, it tells a story that allows you to dive right in not fully knowing

everything about the situation and charters, and completely immerse yourself in this world Brian Wood, Garry Brown and Dave McCaig have created. Have I mentioned the art yet?
