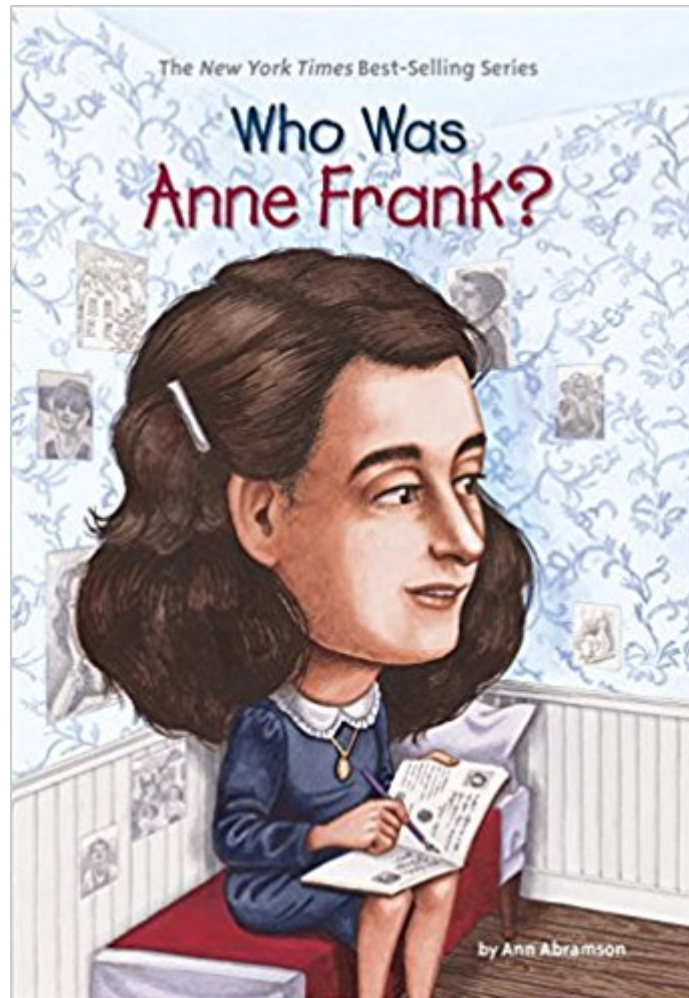

We were covering American history this year (homeschooling family) and I was apprehensive about the subject of the Holocaust as our eldest was only 6.5 but this book was a perfect introduction. It is honest and well written without being overly graphic or inappropriate for younger readers. We used it as a read aloud so that we could address any questions or concerns and we will use it again with our other children as they get older

My 9yr old daughter chose this as her summer reading and loved it. I was worried about introducing this awful time in history and had her read the book aloud so we could discuss it as she read. It was carefully written with young readers in mind. It takes you through her life story in a very sensitive manner. It allows the reader to understand the hardships she went through, without being too graphic.
