

LeSieg and Rosetta Stone) have been translated into thirty languages. Hundreds of millions of copies have found their way into homes and hearts around the world. Dr. Seussâ€¢s long list of awards includes Caldecott Honors for *McElligotâ€¢s Pool*, *If I Ran the Zoo*, and *Bartholomew and the Oobleck*, the Pulitzer Prize, and eight honorary doctorates.
