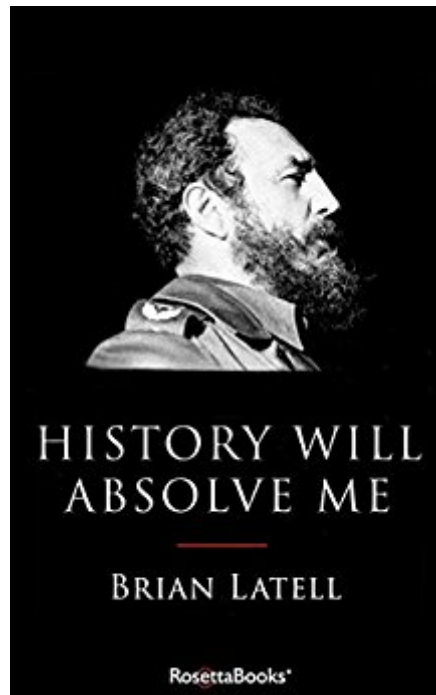




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History Will Absolve Me: Fidel Castro: Life And Legacy (Kindle Single)

He is also the author of *After Fidel: Raul Castro and the Future of Cuba's Revolution*, which has been published in eight languages around the world, as well as *Castro's Secret: Cuban Intelligence, the CIA, and the Assassination of John F. Kennedy*.
