

The invasion of Panama in 1989 is one of those forgotten wars in American military history. Codenamed Operation Just Cause, the operation was launched by President Bush to remove Panamanian dictator Manuel Noriega from power after he had killed a U.S. Marine and declared war on the United States. The book does a good job covering the conflict itself, which lasted only several weeks and resulted in low casualties for the United States, as well as covering the uniforms and weapons of both the American and Panamanian forces. Not much has been written about the invasion of Panama so this book is a good start.
