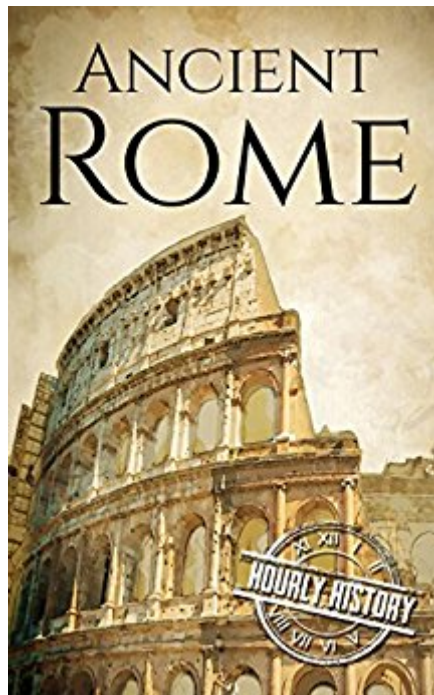




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Ancient Rome: A History From Beginning To End (Ancient Civilizations Book 1)
