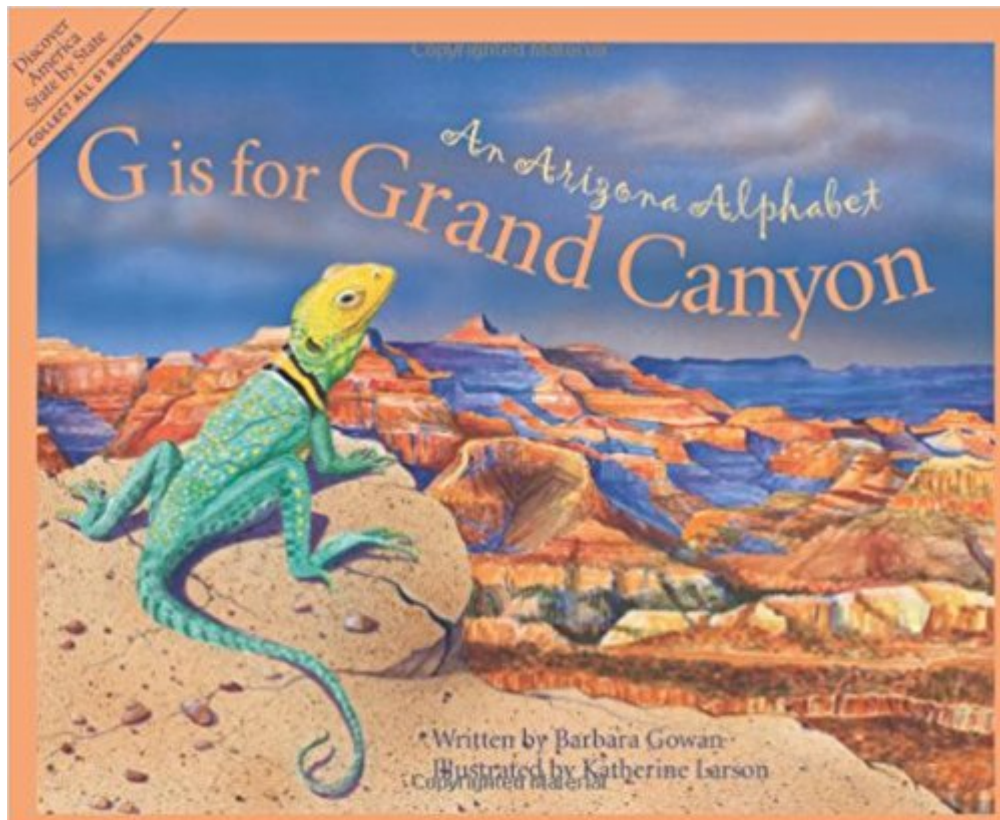

Also the book felt redundant-themed at times and included a few things that just did not seem special enough to worthy inclusion. I also do not like that some letters have two page spreads and some only one page. I wish all the letters were treated the same for consistency.
