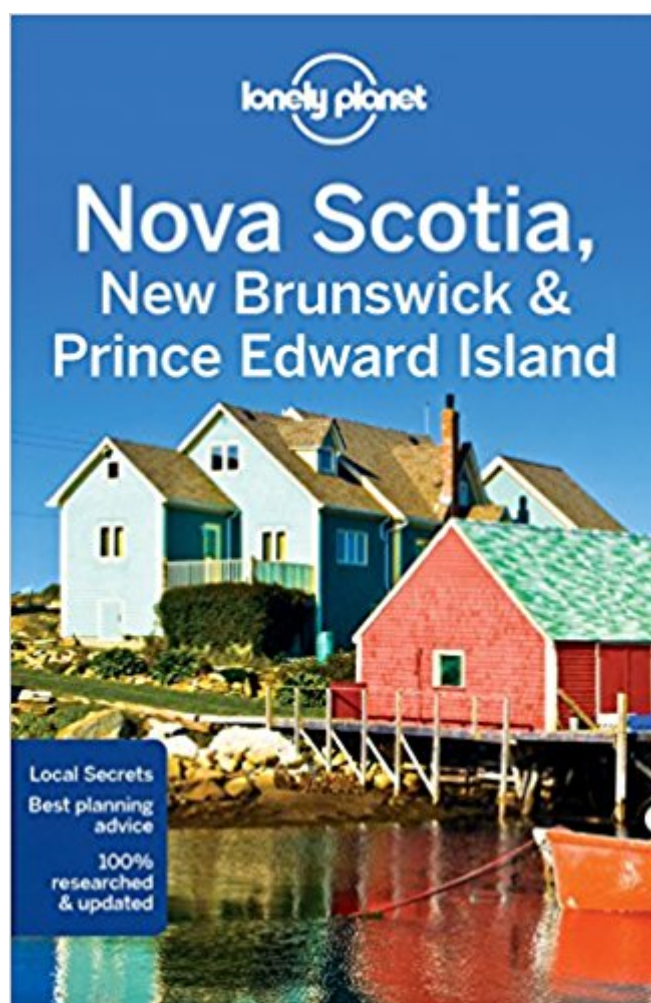

Disappointing. This guide is really nothing more than a collection of small descriptions of locations, things to do, some (few) places to stay and eat, etc. There is very little in the way of detail. It offered nothing more (and in many cases less) than the official Nova Scotia tourism guide available free. Though the stated publication date is 2017, its accuracy is suspect. For example, it references the "discontinued" ferry service between Maine and Yarmouth, NS. That service was seasonably resumed several years ago- what else is dated or wrong? There are few pictures. Generally an "OK" guide, nothing special.

This is a good little travel book if planning or considering making the trip to Nova Scotia area. Good info, pictures, routes to choose, lodging, travel itineraries.

I used this guide as well as another. Though I preferred the other guide to this I did like this guide. It's well laid out. It could have been more informative.
