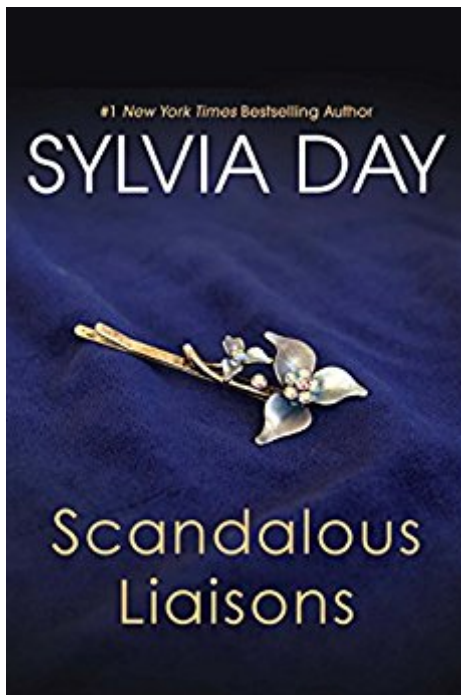


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Scandalous Liaisons

I enjoyed all 3 of the stories very much...the first time I read them in "Bad Boys Ahoy". I bought this one (and this is completely my fault) without reading the reviews simply because I have enjoyed all of her historic settings and novels. It didn't occur to me that they would have re-named and re-packaged the same 3 stories. So disappointing. Sum it up...if you haven't read the first packaged trilogy, then you might just love this!!

I have read and enjoyed this author's work before but was disappointed with this book. While the other books I read had interesting plot lines, in that area this book (particularly the first story) was lacking. Perhaps, it was due to the length of the stories. If what you are looking for is historical romance, I would suggest looking elsewhere. If you are looking for short stories full of sex with little plot development, then you may enjoy this book.

I really love how she makes the short stories all to intertwine together. I have always loved history romance. This one took my breath away! The emotions and the feuding to the falling in love the chase and the meaning you can't always make yourself love another when you love another. Recommend it to anyone!
