

We are proud to publish titles of interest to all musicians as well as music lovers, from songbooks and instructional titles to artist biographies and instrument price guides to books about the music industry and all the performing arts.

This seems like a nice selection (haven't tried playing them yet) and it's printed on a nice cream paper. But I wish had shown a "look inside" as there are NO fingering suggestions whatsoever. That might be acceptable for an advanced book, but for easy-intermediate I expect fingering. It just doesn't make sense for Hal Leonard not to work out the best fingering once during production,

instead of having every owner muddle through working it out on their own. I often change the finger a little from what is suggested, but it's usually a good starting point. I bought four of these books (two easy, two intermediate-early advanced), but in future I'll stick with Alfred Publishing books (which not only have fingering, but some nice text up front with a suggested order of study, useful since I'm self-taught now).

My daughter played out of this book about ten years ago but took it with her when she moved out. I was so happy to find the book again for myself. The arrangements are easy to play.

Nice selection of classical themes in arrangements I could just sit down and play. Good for people like me who don't get time to play very often but love the music of the masters.
